

CURATED SURFACES

What They Are...

The Curated Surfaces Collection features engineered materials in a variety of textures, colors and gloss levels. Here's a quick primer on how each is made, plus care suggestions.

TSS

Made in Italy from a manufacturer who's been producing textured material for over 40 years, TSS offers consistent color and texture throughout a design.

TSS panels are made from wood grain decorative papers. The paper is treated with resins that are heat and pressure bonded to create a Thermo Structured Surface. A hardening treatment that is synched to the texture in the wood grain creates the 3D effect of raised grain.

CARE: This extremely durable, easy-to-clean surface requires only a soft cloth dampened with warm, soapy water. Blot or lightly wipe the spill, then dry quickly with a clean, soft cloth.

Do not use abrasives, harsh chemicals, or magic erasers. Wax-based cleansers, Murphy soap and Pledge should also be avoided, as they can change the color.

SM Foil

Capture the look of ultra low gloss paint in a seamless, durable surface that works well in today's contemporary designs.

As the name suggests, Super Matte foils have almost zero reflectivity. To create the look, low gloss foils are pressed to and around an engineered core. The lack of seams gives a clean look without the visible joints common in painted wood.

CARE: SM products come with a protective peel coat that must be removed after installation is complete. Wipe with a damp cotton cloth or sponge with mild dish soap. For oily or tacky stains, a 50/50 mix of water and Simple Green® may be used.

Do not use abrasives (including baking soda), harsh chemicals, or magic erasers. Avoid cleaners containing ammonia.

HG Acrylic

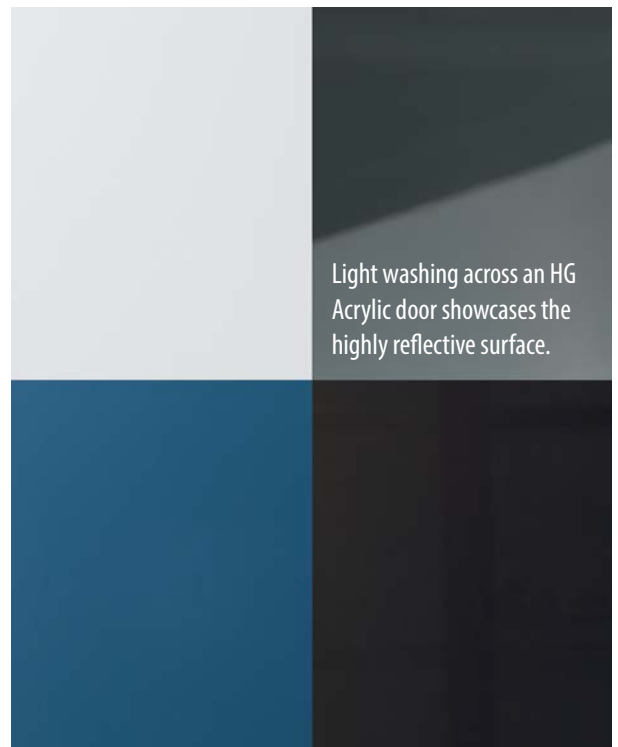
Used alone or in combination with wood or textured cabinets, High Gloss (HG) surfaces bring a sophisticated look to any design.

Acrylic material is a rigid surface that is flat-laminated to the face of a slab-style door or drawer front. Edges are then banded with a matching material or an aluminum-look PVC for modern, square corners. The HG Acrylic finish has a very high sheen with an almost mirror-like luster.

CARE: HG products come with a protective peel coat that must be removed after installation is complete. Clean with highly diluted (1:100) dish soap and water.

Do not use abrasives, harsh chemicals, or magic erasers. Avoid cleaners containing ammonia.

Read the manufacturer's full care instructions.

HG Foil

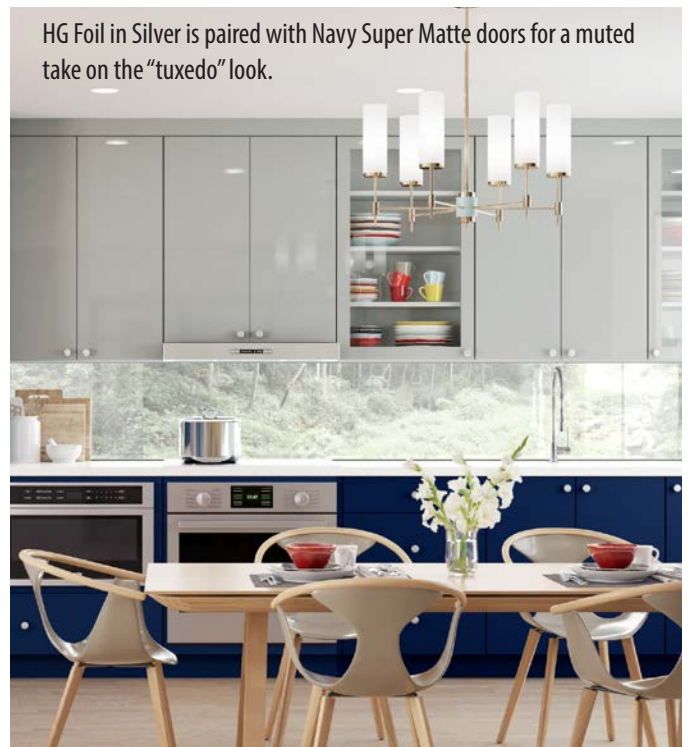
Used alone or in combination with wood or textured cabinets, High Gloss (HG) surfaces bring a sophisticated look to any design.

HG Foils are a flexible product that is pressed over the face and sides of a panel with lightly eased edges. The look is clean, smooth and seamless. As with HG Acrylics, HG Foils are highly reflective. These high gloss styles mix well with Super Mattes and the wood-look doors found in TSS.

CARE: HG products come with a protective peel coat that must be removed after installation is complete. Clean with highly diluted (1:100) dish soap and water.

Do not use abrasives, harsh chemicals, or magic erasers. Avoid cleaners containing ammonia.

HG Foil in Silver is paired with Navy Super Matte doors for a muted take on the "tuxedo" look.
